## Essay Competition – 2021

The Indian Academy of Oral Medicine & Radiology (IAOMR) is pleased to announce the IAOMR Essay Competition-2021. Entries are invited in the respective THREE categories from all eligible participants, subject to the following rules : -

1. Only ---

- Category (1) Undergraduate (B.D.S.) students (UG Category),
- Category (2) Postgraduate students of Oral Medicine & Radiology, who are members of IAOMR (PG Category), and
- Category (3) Specialists in Oral Medicine & Radiology, who are members of IAOMR:
  - (3a) Teaching Staff of DCI (Dental Council of India) / MCI (Medical Council of India) approved / recognized, Dental / Medical Colleges (Faculty Category), Or
  - (3b) Practitioner Category: Doctors holding an M.D.S. degree in the specialty of Oral Medicine, Diagnosis & Radiology or equivalent, as recognized by the DCI.

--- are eligible to compete.

- 2. Soft copy of the Essay neatly typed in Microsoft® Word, should be sent as specified below :
  - (a) Page size : A-4,
  - (b) Margins : Top = 1.5 cms, Bottom = 1.5 cms, Left = 2.75, Right = 1.5 cms,
  - (c) Single-Line spacing,
  - (d) Paragraph Alignment : Justified & vertically aligned at the top of the page,
  - (e) Font : Times New Roman,
  - (f) Font Size : 12,
  - (g) New paragraphs to be aligned with the left margin (with zero indentation from the left margin) and with 1.5 line spacing between two paragraphs.
  - (h) Essay Title & Sub-Titles (if any in the text) should be typed in capital & bold letters,
  - (i) Maximum words : 2500.
- 3. Only SOFT COPY of the Essay should be sent by email as a Microsoft® Word Document attachment to [2021iaomrcompetition@gmail.com](mailto:2021iaomrcompetition@gmail.com) with the subject of the email as “IAOMR Essay Competition–2021, Category 1 / 2 / 3A / 3B” (Type the respective category you belong to).
- 4. Entries should not contain any pictures. Entries with pictures shall be disqualified.
- 5. IMPORTANT: Name / address / other identifying data of the participant, such as college, city, university, telephone no. etc. should not appear anywhere in the text of the Essay. No personal identification or markings are permitted in the pages.
- 6. For category 1, each essay sent by email shall contain the following as attachments:
  - (a) Filled and scanned copy of the entry form (as per the format prescribed), and
  - (b) One scanned stamp size color photograph of the author.
- 7. For categories 2 and 3, each essay sent by email shall contain the following as attachments:
  - (a) Filled and scanned copy of the entry form (as per the format prescribed),
  - (b) A self-attested photocopy of their B.D.S. certificate (for category 2 entries), and M.D.S. certificate (for categories 3a and 3b entries), and
  - (c) One scanned stamp size color photograph of the author.
- 8. Last date for the entries to reach the above-mentioned e-mail ([2021iaomrcompetition@gmail.com](mailto:2021iaomrcompetition@gmail.com)) is 31-10-2021. Entries received after the last date will not be considered for the competition.
- 9. An Awards Committee constituted by IAOMR would go into the merits of all essays received, and decide the best among them.
