General Guidelines

- 1. Registration is mandatory for all events.
- 2. One delegate can present either poster or paper.
- 3. Time allotted for Paper Presentation is 7mins (5+2) and for Poster presentation is 5 mins (3+2).
- 4. The best 30 abstracts will be selected for paper presentation.
- 5. Strict adherence to the time should be followed.
- 6. The final decision regarding the papers or posters will be decided by the organizing committee.
- 7. Poster and Paper presentation should be mailed before the last date of submission to nationaliaomrugconvention2025@gmail.com



1. Abstract Submission: 30th August 2025

2. E-Poster Submission: 10th September 2025



- 1. The author's identity and college name should not be mentioned in the abstract.
- 2. The abstract for paper and poster presentation should be submitted in either of the three categories namely original research, case-report/case series and review.
- 3. Abstract should not exceed the word limit of 250
- 4. Kindly maintain a uniform font of Times New Roman 12 for content and 14 for headings.
- 5. The titles should be clear and won't be changed once submitted.
- 6. Abstracts will be scrutinized by our scientific team










- 1. Original research/interesting case report/case series/review can be presented
- 2. Presentation code assigned to the candidate should be mentioned on the bottom left corner of the presentation
- 3. Name of the presenter/guide/institution should not be mentioned on the poster
- 4. Time allotted is 5 min (3 min for presentation and 2 min for discussion) (adherence to time limit is important)
- 5. Posters should be submitted in the form of E-posters only in JPEG format at a minimum resolution of 600 dpi and in 16:9 aspect ratio (Landscape mode)
- 6. One poster presentation can have two participant one as author and one as co-author
- 7. Authors of the poster have to present during the poster display session. The time slot for the poster will be intimated to the authors beforehand.
- 8. Presenters should report to their respective halls 30 minutes prior to their schedule





- 2. Original research/interesting case report/ case series/ reviews can be presented.
- 3. The presentation code assigned to the candidate should be mentioned on the first slide of the presentation
- 4. Name of the presenter/ guide/ institution should not be mentioned on the PPT of paper presentation
- 5. Time allotted is 7 min (5 min for presentation and 2 min for discussion) (adherence to time limit is important)
- 6. One paper presentation can have only one participant.
- 7. The presentation should be prepared in Microsoft office Powerpoint 2007 and above
- 8. Presenters should report to their respective halls 30 minutes prior to their schedule.









- 1. Only one team per college is allowed.
- 2. Candidates per team will be allowed.
- 3. Judges decision will be final.
